


Crochet Guild Australia is an incorporated not-for-profit established in late 2019 by a core group of passionate crochet enthusiasts and a foundation membership of over 1000 Australians with a shared vision of helping crocheters connect, educate and share knowledge about this beautiful, creative, addictive and traditional craft.

In a few short years, Crochet Guild Australia has created a centralised crochet community resource to provide education, inspiration and teaching tools targeted at crochet enthusiasts, whether hobbyist or professional. The Guild has a wide range of internal and external communication channels with a large following on Facebook and member-specific communications, including:

- Regular member "show and share" zoom meet-ups
- Monthly interviews with international high-profile crochet designers
- Quarterly Digital Newsletters – packed with yarn promotions, discount codes, interviews with designers and guild members

- Regular email communications to members promoting events and discounts

Following the Conference, the Guild will launch local Chapters, allowing local members to meet in person for the first time. This new initiative follows the ending of Covid Safe procedures across the country.

National Crochet Conference 2023

Crochet Guild Australia aims to hold a National Conference annually. The 2023 Conference will be held between 1-3 June 2023 at the Wesley Conference Centre, Pitt Street, located in Sydney's CBD.

We expect over 4,000 highly engaged visitors to attend our 2023 National Crochet Conference.

The Conference will provide three days of inspiration and entertainment for Australian crafters. Our event will include workshops, presentations and




networking events. A highlight of this year's Conference is a Boutique Yarn Market and Specialist Displays open to all attendees.


