

## Clones Knots for Jewellery

### **Stitch Knowledge required:**

A good control of tension, a working knowledge of abbreviations, e.g., yoh. Stitches used – chain (ch), double crochet (dc), treble crochet (tr), picot. The Clones Knot will be taught (or practiced) in class.

### **Description**

Participants will try different ways to use Clones Knots in braids with an ultimate aim of creating a piece of jewellery. The patterns will range from traditional Irish Crochet style to Funky Modern. While the patterns are inventions, they take inspiration from found images. All of them emphasise the Clones Knot. Printed patterns will be provided.



### **Materials required:**

#### **Participant to bring**

- A range of yarns and threads in cotton, stranded cotton, rayon or silk. Wool is not usually appropriate for something that will go around the neck. A range of sizes of thread/yarn – for example 3 ply, 4 ply, DMC 8, Cebelia 20
- Hook sizes ranging from 1.00 up. The best style for Clones Knots have a narrow section close to the hook, widening as it moves up the shaft. Steel is preferred for 'slipperiness'. A general rule of thumb is a smaller sized hook than is regularly used for the choice of thread/yarn.
- General kit - scissors, tapestry needles, E6000 glue, earring findings, note paper and pen.
