Homework required:

Students will need to do and bring homework done in 8 ply wool.
The homework instructions for this will be sent to you after you register for class.

Description

This is one of the rarest of Madame Weigel's designs for tea cosies and the wonderful effect of this technique creates an intrigue that will be demystified in class.

Take a walk down memory lane in recreating a wonderful slice of Australian history. And if you haven't had the pleasure of discovering Madame Weigel's influence on our history then just do an online search. I think you will be delightfully surprised. Our guest speaker for the banquet will enlighten us more.

You will need to do some homework before class to give you a base on which to work the honeycomb stitch itself.

This class is suitable for anyone who can read a pattern and is familiar with treble crochet & working in rows.

The pattern has been updated from the original to make it easier to understand.

Materials required:

Participant to bring

- 8ply wool/natural fibre (this is because acrylic can sometimes melt from the heat of the teapot) but if you are just making a sample any 8ply is okay.
- Approximately 50 gm 8ply required for the cosy, plus 50gms 8ply in a contrast colour.
- 4mm or 4.5mm hook
