Description

Crochet and explore the principles of netting as seen in Irish crochet.

Explore the differing styles of netting.

Lynn will be hosting a raffle prize draw during this class.



Materials required:

Participant to bring

- 0.50mm, 1.75mm 1.00mm crochet hook and assorted fine threads from Size 10,20 thread to 4ply with which to experiment and quilting thread if they have it at home already.
- Students will need to bring contrast sewing cotton and a sewing needle.
- Felt mats are available for purchase in class (approx. \$5)
- Netting Beginners can bring # 10 or #20 thread with 1.75 and .90 or 1.00 crochet hook.
- If thread is too fine. Bring 4ply cotton and a 1.75 or 2.25 hook.
- Netting Intermediate can bring 1.75 and a .50 hook. Threads #40 #80
- If the participants can bring motifs that the netting can be applied to it would be a bonus.

The two types of threads will give a variation in the netting, and the effects that can be achieved.

I will use 4ply wool in demonstrations.
